Hilo

In the heart of the Big Island's lush rainforest lies the remote and stunning Waipi'o Valley, once the capital of Hawaii and permanent residence of many early Hawaiian ali'i (kings). Take an exhilarating adventure by land or air to dramatic volcano eruption sites and cascading waterfalls, surrounded by natural tropical beauty.

Maui (Lahaina)

Discover stunning views at the great Haleakala National Park and the vibrant marine life of the Ma'ālaea Bay at Maui Ocean Center. Walk the path to the Iao Valley, a true tropical paradise, or even go on an exciting whale-watching adventure.

Kauai (Nawiliwili), Hawaii

The fourth largest island in the Hawaiian rroup, Kauai is known as the "Garden Island." The terrain ranges from the volcanic lopes of Mt. Waialeale and the desert-like beauty of Waimea Canyon to the Wailua River's lush Fern Grotto.

Ironically this once isolated island as the site of the first meeting between Europeans and Hawaiians. On January 19, 1778, Captain James Cook anchored his ships off the mouth of the Waimea River, becoming the first in a long line of enthusiastic visitors. Kauai was never conquered by the great warrior King Kamehameha.
